# Climate feared more than terror: poll

Canadians believe climate change poses a significantly bigger threat to the "vital interests" of this country over the next decade than international terrorism, a new poll suggests. While nearly half of those surveyed said climate change is a "critical threat," only about one in four people said the same about international terrorism. A similar poll conducted in 2004 showed Canadians believed the two threats were about equal. The results come from a survey commissioned by the Canadian Defence and Foreign Affairs Institute and conducted by the Innovative Research Group. While fears about climate change remained relatively stable, falling three percentage points from 52% in 2004 to 49% in 2010, international terrorism tumbled from 49% In 2004 To 28% In 2010.
